### ABOUT THE BURSARY

A bursary for the maximum of **R80 000.00** per annum will be awarded to successful candidates covering the costs for tuition fees, prescribed books/stationery, residence costs and meals.

### ELIGIBILITY

- Both under-graduate and post-graduate candidates may apply
- Immediate CETA employee's family members may not apply
- Students currently funded through CETA funded entities may not apply
- Full times students registered with a public institution of their choice may apply
- Applications will only be considered from South African citizens

### SELECTION CRITERIA

- 60% Grade 12 academic achievements with both Mathematics and Physical Science at level 5 or above
- No Bursaries will be granted to existing students who are not promoted to the next year of study and have failed more than two subjects
- Applications from designated groups will be given preference.

### SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

- Certified copy of ID document
- Certified copy of guardian/parents proof of income or social grant/pension
- Letter of acceptance from tertiary institution: University or University of Technology
- Full academic history for students already studying at University or University of Technology
- Grade 12 June 2017 results for Matriculants
- Age (not more than 35 years of age)
- Income (parents not earning more than R350k per annum)
